

Policy Agreement - Independent Body Agreement

The UCSA Board and the Independent Body (IB) hereby agree that:

1. The IB is asked to count votes during General Assemblies (GA's). When doing so, votes of the IB members counting may not be casted publicly.
2. The IB has a 0-tolerance policy on sanctions imposed on the members of the IB by the UCSA Board, as we believe that IB members should have impeccable behaviour. If a member of the IB does get a sanction (e.g. a bar ban), recruitment will start for a new member and they will be replaced at the next GA.
3. When dealing with an appeal, the IB will send out a temporary report and decision to all parties involved, they have 48 hours to send the IB any other new relevant points. The IB will consider these new points, otherwise the temporary decision will be final.
4. Whenever the UCSA board wants to propose changes to the statutes and/or policy manual, they will ask the IB for a double check before the GA.
